

ALLEN FRIZZELL, also known as "the other brother," was born into a family rich in Country Music tradition. Since the early 1950s, the Frizzell brothers have been prominent on the music charts as artists and songwriters, their songs have been recorded by George Jones, Willie Nelson, Merle Haggard, Keith Whitley and pop artist Jewel.



Allen is the youngest brother of two well-known Country Music artists. His elder brother is the iconic Country Music legend, Lefty Frizzell. Known as the most influential Country Music vocalist of all time, Lefty laid a foundation for the many generations of Country Music performers that followed him. And second-oldest brother, David Frizzell, the Grammy-nominated, Academy of Country Music (ACM) and Academy of Country Music (CMA) award winner, as well as two-time Song-of – the-Year honors recipient.

Like Lefty and David, Allen is more than a great vocalist. He is also a talented musician who truly captures the emotion of a song. Additionally, Allen is an outstanding songwriter who earned Broadcast Music, Inc. (BMl's) prestigious Million-Air performance award, (BMl's official recognition of achievement in American Music).

Allen started his musical journey at the age of 19, singing and playing guitar with his two older brothers. Allen soon realized he should forge his own path musically. Having recently become a Christian and on fire for the Lord, he felt the call to sing Gospel Music. He proudly put together a three-piece band ministering around California but with little encouragement, he began to follow in his older brother's footsteps singing Country Music and began working the West Coast. It soon paid off! Allen opened a show for Dottie West who, impressed with his talent, insisted he move to Nashville and work for her. Not many years later, Allen signed with MCA and Sony Records as a recording artist.

He is now celebrating success in a different genre, Christian Country Music. He has celebrated numerous awards along with several #1 songs since the release of his first Christian Country CD in 2007. His most recent #1 song came in February 2017, with a song from his new CD, "About My Father's Business."

Allen is humbly grateful for the success he has received in Christian Country Music, but he will proudly tell you that this is not why he does what he does; as from the heart he states, "It's all about HIM, not about me."
